
AFN GIVE-AWAY PARTY CRASHED

Most attendees were prancing around like peacocks, in gangsta' garb. Black pants and shirts with gold chains around their necks, diamond and gold rings on their fingers and sparkly bracelets on their arms and hanging from their noses and ears. They were plucked and primmed for the big show.

The great white auntie Carolyn Bennett is on stage encouraging them to sign up and shut up, "Come on, boys and gurls. We're gonna give you this much for the native stash we already stole from you. We will give you the right carry out the genocide on whoever you select of your

people. Just rubber stamp this. The natives won't know. We'll keep them sick, starving, confused and killed".

The grandmother and grandchildren crashed this glittering ball. They represent the kaianerekowa, the great peace, of the original people.

Auntie reassured her babes in the AFN toyland, "Don't worry, only you market place Indians will be heard. Everybody else is blacklisted".

Grandmother spoke for less than 4 minutes. A few of the sell-out crowd of sell-outs followed them out. The rest stayed behind to continue making deals with the slime buckets.

The Indians are given instructions on what to do and think about the decisions of their scammers. Joe Norton of the Indian Act Mohawk Council of Kahnawake Inc. announced he will continue to defy the Montreal courts' decision on violating human rights. The government and AFN are setting up private corporations in the middle of our communities to be controlled by a few sell-outs in partnership with private militias.

We have to keep on drinking sewage so our skin can stay raw and our bodies remain sick. We will be watched and laughed at.

Cariboo will be protected, pipelines, dams and garbage will litter our mother. We can't hunt to eat, no place to plant food we can eat or shit on our polluted land.

We are the sovereigns. Not one inch of turtle island can be expropriated by anyone. Our mother, trees, animals, waters, air and the people have to be free. We must go back to the day before first contact so we can have unmolested enjoyment as the original people forever on the land.

The dilemma for the sell-outs is "Should I stay or should I go now?": "Should I stay or should I go now? Should I stay or should I go now? If I go, there will be trouble. And if I stay it will be double. So come on and let me know".
