Dear Dr. James:

I have your letter of the 2nd inst. I note your suggestion with reference to Selective Service deferment. I am writing to Dr. J. Clemmons, Chairman, Procurement and Assignment Service of New York State, 122 E. 42nd St., New York, N. Y. asking him if a year's deferment can be obtained. Procurement and Assignment has now become part of the Selective Service organization and it is through this body that the medical school has obtained deferments for its essential staff.

It would seem to me that a confirmative letter from you might be most useful. I have some rather uncertain recollection from our discussions in Montreal that the Canadian army was interested in the establishment of a Department of Psychiatry at McGill in so far that it might be of assistance in their program of training army psychiatrists. I do not know whether this is sufficiently concrete to render it of value as a point to be brought out in the letter.
