Anticipated additional sources of revenue:

As indicated in Principal James' letter of December 13, 1948, to Dr. Gregg, the former is planning to place before the MoGill Governors a proposal that, as the Rockefeller grant to the Department of Psychiatry tapers, this support will be taken over progressively by the general funds of the University.

During the last five years we have followed a policy of building up research funds from three main sources: (a) government, (b) foundations, (c) industry.
