Scientific Meeting

The research group in Forensic Psychiatry is planning to hold a scientific meeting jointly with the Treatment Staff of St. Vincent de Paul Penitentiary, and the Treatment Staff of Kingston Penitentiary.

I am enclosing a programme of this meeting to be held in March 13, and 14, 1959. This meeting will be attended on personal invitation and we expect about 40 or 50 people who are actively working in the field of the rehabilitation of offender.

As this meeting will be presented by the Department of Psychiatry of McGill University, I gather that you have no objections that the Department of Psychiatry officially cosponsor this meeting.

I would appreciate your comments immediately, as we would like to put this in print on Monday.
